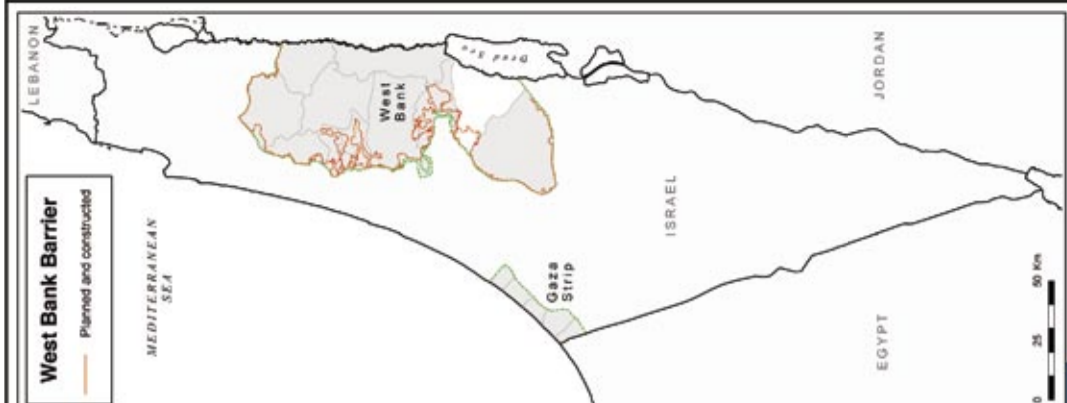
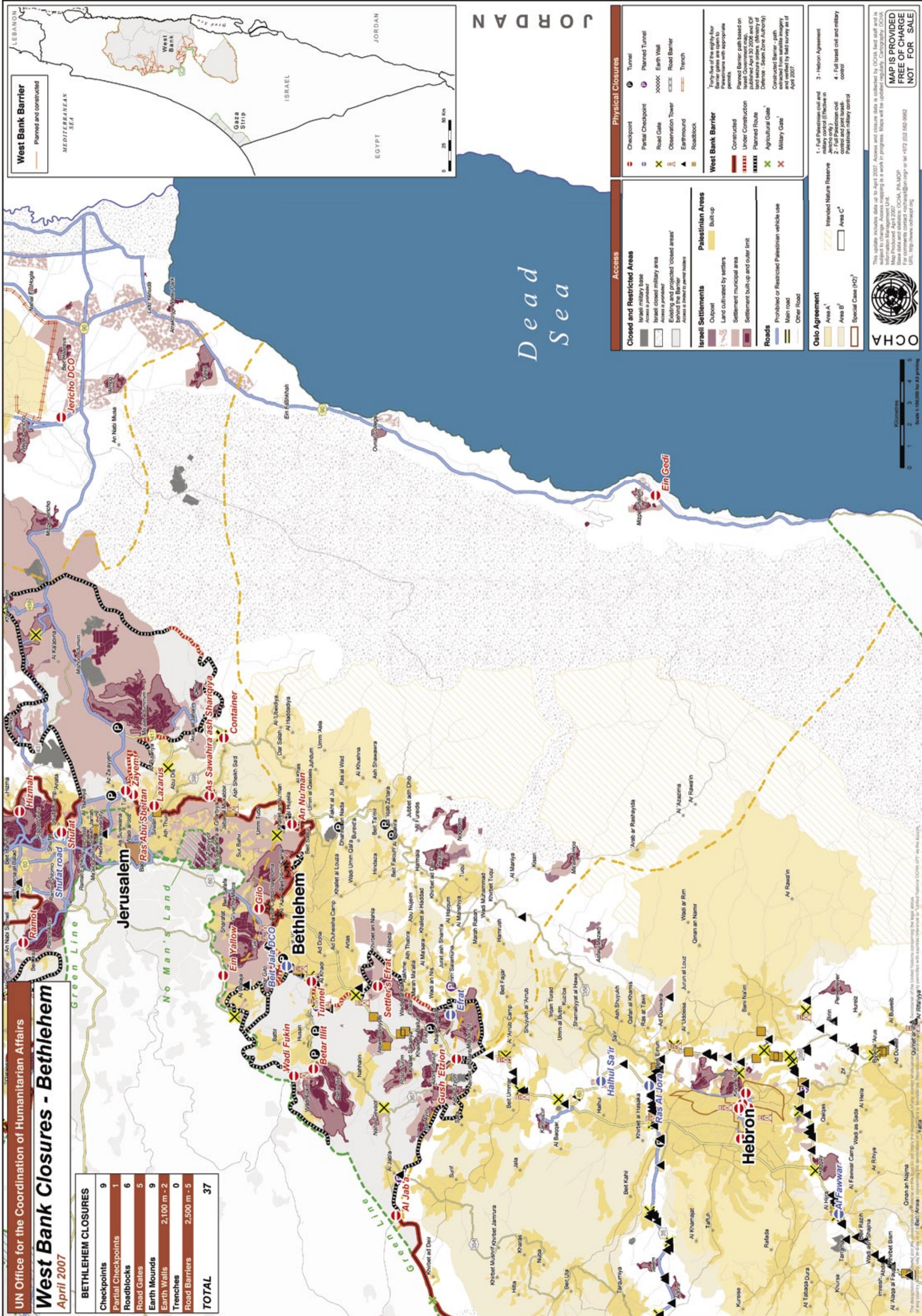

West Bank Barrier

Terraces of the eight-bar barrier gates are subject to Permits with appropriate permits.

Continued Barrier - path extracted from satellite imagery and verified by field survey as of April 2007.

1 - Full Palestinian civil and military control (Effective in Jericho only)

4 - Full Israeli civil and military control

5 - Palestinian military control
