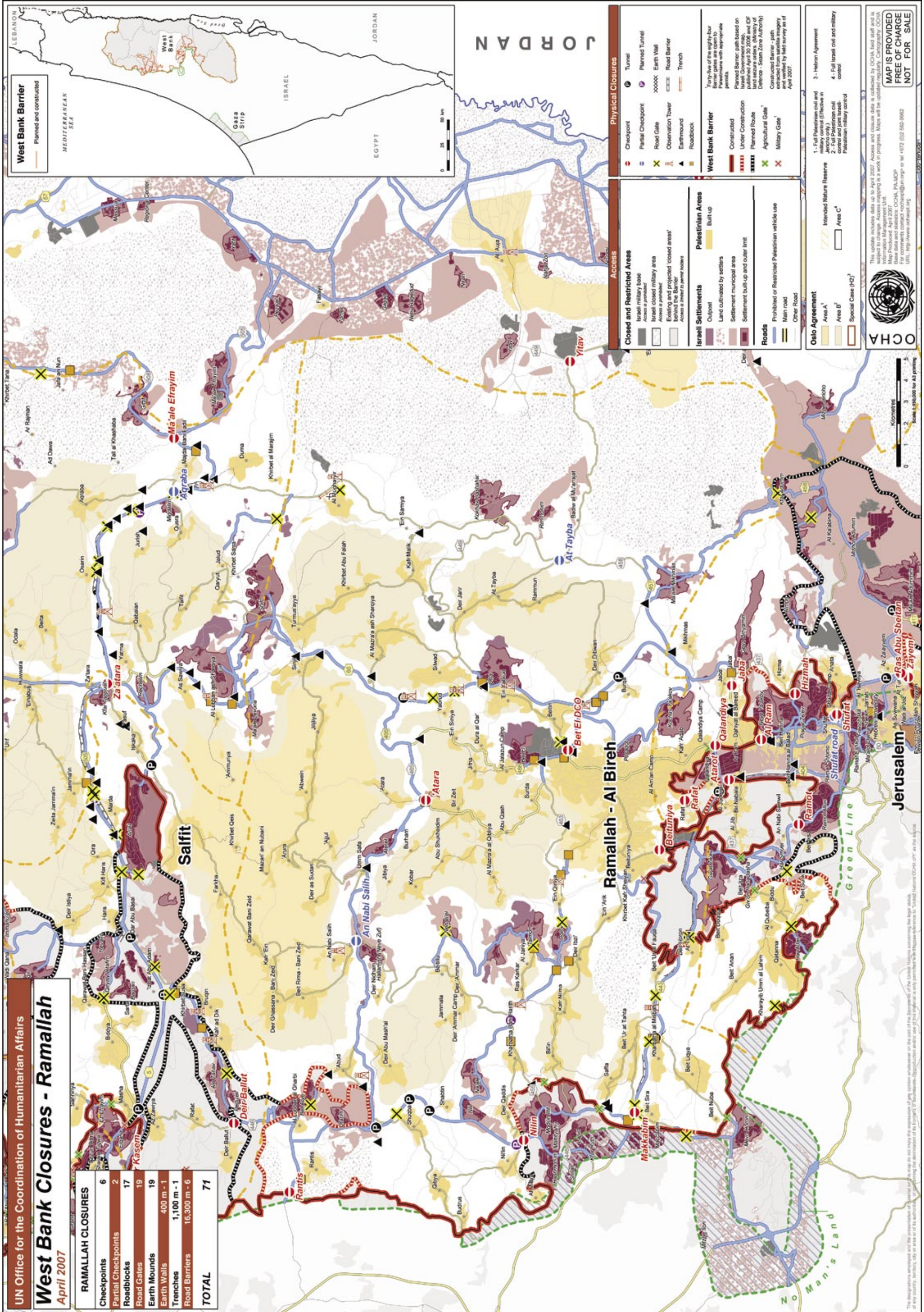

Terraces of the eight-bar barrier gates are subject to Permits from the appropriate permits.

Constructed Barrier - path extracted from satellite imagery and verified by field survey as of April 2007.
